## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**



## By submitting works to the Lifeline Art Show North Sydney, you acknowledge agreement to the following:

- 1) The exhibition is open to all artists, styles and experience.
- 2) There is no limit to the number of entries per artist (depending on size) and all entries must be the original and unaided work of the entrant.
- 3) Any late changes to the accepted/confirmed art works after **Friday 28th March** may or may not be accepted due to space or label printing.
- 4) The art work can be in any form, watercolour, oil, sketches etc.
- 5) The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 6) The entries **must** be suitably framed with D hooks or equivalent hanging attachments. Hooks and wires must be attached and ready to be hung.
- 7) Name, Phone number, Price of work and Title of work must be clearly marked at drop off.
- A label PDF will be sent via email for each accepted work to secure to the back of the entry.
- 8) The Art Entry Fee's are non-refundable, irrespective of acceptance.
- 9) No entries can be removed during the Exhibition.
- 10) A commission of 40% will be deducted from each item sold, which will be donated to Lifeline Harbour to Hawkesbury Sydney.
- 11) Insurance is the full responsibility of the entrant. All care will be taken, but Lifeline Harbour to Hawkesbury Sydney and North Sydney Council will accept no responsibility for loss or damage to the works.
- 12) Drop off and collection of works will be the responsibility of the entrant. Works not collected by the time and date specified will be disposed of at the discretion of Lifeline Harbour to Hawkesbury Sydney (unless other arrangements have been made).
- 13) Art works are to be delivered to Fred Hutley Hall on **Sunday 30th March between 10am–1pm or Monday 31st March between 2pm–5:30pm.**
- 14) All Art works not sold must be collected from Fred Hutley Hall on **Thursday 10 April** between 9am–6pm.
- 15) Entrants shall allow their work to be reproduced for publicity purposes and waive any copyright claims in this instant.
- 16) A small number of paintings will be chosen to be auctioned on the Opening night. This will be the decision of Lifeline Harbour to Hawkesbury Sydney.
